wyff also I will that if Thomas mynlynght and all other myn froppe to my wyff or her assignee in my  
land and tenent of myne the said Richard heronday immediately after my decease delive to my wyff my  
wyff my eyerunge a tenent called Seyndeyn wch all the land wood garden and other appertynent to the  
said eyerunge a tenent belonging hynge and being upon the demyse of Seyndeyn a assignee for term of  
her lyf And also I will that the said my wyff in likewise have y piece of land a wood hynge  
upon the demyse of flalstot called the marlynght a the eyde also I in likewise to the said my wyff  
my wyff a wood called Tharnd myn spread hynge upon the demyse of Seyndeyn containing y acre  
And also I will in likewise to the said my wyff all my land a tenent garden wch appertynent  
hynge and being within the parish of Westfawley to have all the pmisses aforesaid to the said my wyff  
for term of her lyff and aft her decease to remaine to Edward my sonne and to his heires in fee. Also  
I will to my wyff all those yerles whiche I have in Westfawley Court and if she dye before  
the yerle be appointed then I will it remaine to Edward my sonne and if he dye then I will it remaine  
to Thomas Chapman and Barbara his wyff and if they both dye then I will it remaine to my  
eldest daughter being on lyve. Also I will to my wyff all other goodly and reasonable  
good and cattall whiche I had at the making of this my last will wch condition that she  
truly paye all my dettes and bequestes first to my brother John wch whiche is bequeyted hym by the  
last wyll of my father that is to saye within four yerles next ensuving after my wythier in laded  
decease yearly to h. Also I will that my wyff kepe to stole Edward my sonne till he come to his  
age of 20 yerles And then I will she send hym p wntys in London to some honest Craft tyll he  
comyth to his age of 20 yerles And when he comyth out of his p wntys I will she shall  
delive hym 100 lb of money and myn hoope Ring of gold And if he marrye his wythier lemyng I
