 Also I will that after my decease the said William shall have my messuage in the high strete where  
 nowre Richard hynnsley dwelleth in fynyntyme con Kaplyn to him and to his heire forev. Also  
 I will that after my decease John ffisher the younger immediately after my decease shall have a tenement  
 in Wyke strete voluys: fynyntyme was Gullyb with a gardyn and a barne belonging to the same with  
 thappenture to him and to his heire forev. Also I will that the said John ffisher shall have a  
 tenement in Wyke strete asof said voluys: fynyntyme was ffirchme with a gardyn belonging to the same  
 to thappenture to him and to his heire forev: as in a dede therof more playnly doth appere of the  
 said house to thappenture. Also I will that Robert ffisher shall have two houses in Wyke strete next  
 unto the house fynyntyme was Newells to him and to his heire forev. Also I will that Thomas  
 Woodyer my son shall have my house in Wyke lane fynyntyme Thomas Standerd dwelled in for all  
 terme of his lyf. Lymng sufficient reparacions and after his decease to remaine to John ffisher thelder  
 to him and to his heire of his body lawfully begotten. And for lack of such issue to remaine therof  
 according to my husbonds will.

 blessed lady of Walden asof said besyde my grave there where as I am accustomed to sit. Item I bequeit  
 to the high altar of the same Church for my tithes and offerings forgotten me my self I bequeit  
 to the more welle in the same Church. And to the brethren of the fraternite of the holy trinitie  
 founded in the same Church to tithes of the same fraternite. Item I will that myn executor  
 do hire or conducte immediately after my decease an honest prest to singe for my soule my frends soules  
 and all open soules from the said Church by the space of one year. And that they paye or cause to be  
 paid to the said prest for his salary and wages for the same year. And the residue of all my  
 goodes that my present testament and last wille performe and my dette paid I give to Margery my  
 wife whom I ordeyn and make my ple executor. For dreding god to dispense with me for the welle of  
 my soule and all open soules. And as touching the disposition of all my landes and tenement  
 both free and Copie. First I will that the said Margery have to hir and hir assignes during hir lyf  
 all my messuage or tenement where I nowe dwell according to a dede of freement therof to her and  
 hir self lately made. And after her decease I will that the portions of my said wille shall be  
 the same tenement and of the money therof comyng I will that the said Margery doo immediately after  
 the same sale paye to William Perot my sonne twenty markes. And the residue therof I will to be disposed  
 by the same executor in dede of charite for the welle of my soule and all open soules. Item I will  
 that my said executor shall take and have to hir owne use all the issue and profit that hereafter  
 shall come of my messuage or tenement to thappenture in Walden asof said voluys: John Samage nowre  
 dwelleth. untill such tyme as Jane Shutte come to hir age of xxij years. And than I will that the pte  
 therof shall goo to the same Jane Shutte John Shutte and John Perot sonne to the said William.  
 untill such tyme as my said executor or hir said executor doo sell the same messuage or tenement  
 of voluys tenement I will that the same executor or executor doo make sale and the money therof comyng  
 I will that be paid to the said Jane Shutte John Shutte and John Perot after division therof in four  
 equal portions in fourte following that is to say to the same Jane oon portion therof asof said after the  
 same sale. a fourth money voluys: shall be sufficient for her portion as shall come to hand of my said  
 executor or hir executor. And the residue of the said portions to be paid to the said Jane John
